Recited on the first night only

Blessed are You, Eternal our God, Sovereign of the universe, Who has kept us alive, sustained us, and brought us to this season.



After reciting the blessings and lighting the candles, the following paragraphs should be recited.

"Ha'Neirot halalu anachnu madlikin al hanisim ve'al hanifla'ot, ve'al hat'shu'ot ve'al hamilchamot, sh'asita la'avoteinu bayamim hahem baz'man hazeh, al yedei kohaneicha hakedoshim. Vechol sh'monat yemei Chanukkah, haneirot halalu kodesh hem. Ve'ein lanu reshut le'hishtamesh ba'hem, eh'la lir'otam bilvad, ke'dei le'hodot u'lehalel leshimcha hagadol al nisecha ve'al nifle'otecha ve'al yeshu'otecha."

These lights we kindle upon the miracles, the wonders, the salvations, and the battles which you performed for our ancestors in those days at this season through Your holy priests. During all eight days of Chanukkah these lights are sacred, and we are not permitted to make ordinary use of them, but to look at them in order to express thanks and praise to Your great Name for Your miracles, Your wonders and Your salutations.
